Academic Vocabulary Development

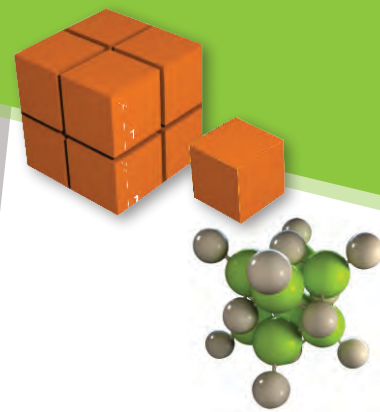
